

By virtue of a warrant from the Commiss^r of property dated the 13th of the
2^d month 1702 for resurveying unto John Hugh two hundred and fifty acres of land
in his possession purchased of Peter Yocum being part of 500 acres granted by
the Proprietary to the said Peter and laid out on part of Latitia Penn's Manor.

Resurveyd unto John Hugh a tract of land on the west side of Schuylkil
— within the bounds of Latitia Penn's Manor. Beginning at a stake at the cor-
ner of the Widow Yocum's land Thence running north ^{no} west one hundred twenty
three perches to a stake in the line of Gunier Rambo's land Then by the same west
south west 335 per. to a dead oak sapling Thence south south east 123 per. to a
stake Thence east north east by W^m Davids land 335 per. to the stake first
above mentioned. Containing two hundred and fifty seven acres. By David Powel
the 4th of ye 6th mo. 1703.
