


FORM No. 1.



By virtue of a warrant from ye Proprietors Commrs dated the 5th day of ye
9th mo. 1714. I survey'd to Richd Harrald a certain tract of land ^{north} of Nottingham
in ye County of Chester.

standing near a branch of north east.
Beginning at a corner marked Chesnut tree thence south west by vacant land
three hundred & thirty perches to a black oak thence east south east by vacant land
two hundred & eighty perches to a post thence north east by a line of marked trees
three hundred & thirty perches to a black ('o - b - " 1 - "') north west by vacant
land two hundred and eighty perches to ye place of Beginning. Containing five
and eighty
hundred ¹/₂ acres with the allowance of six per cent.

Survey'd & laid out by the Genl Surv' ord' the 19th day of April
1716.
