

Resurveyd the 7th of the 3^d month 1716 Pursuant to a warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 23^d of the 2^d month 1716 unto Joshua Hastings of Philadelphia a certain tract of land in the Welch tract in the County of Chester formerly surveyed to him for one hundred and eighty acres as the remainder of his Purchase (of 1000^a) Beginning at a corner tree of Thomas Pascals land (or so reputed) Thence by James Gibbons land west south west one hundred and eighty perches to a corner Then north north west one hundred sixty eight Perches to a corner Then east north east by Griffith Owens land and Robt David's land one hundred and eighty Perches to a corner Then by the said Thomas Pascals land south south east one hundred and sixty eighty Perches to the place of Beginning containing one hundred and eighty nine acres.
