These are in consideration of his Services and good affection to this Govern^t to authorize and require thee to survey and lay out to the sd Captain Finney a lott of land in the third street from Delaware on the east side thereof adjoining to the land bounding on Sassafras street now in the possession of Gabriel Wilkinson to contain in breadth fifty five foot and in Depth one hundred and ninety six foot to be held under the yearly rent of two shillings Sterl. p Annum, And make returns into the General Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this warrt is to remain and a copy thereof to be delv^d to thee certified by the Secy. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 28th day of the 11th Moth 1705.
