

I do hereby certify that by virtue of a warrant under the hands of the Commissioner of Propertie and the seal of the Province to David Powel Directed bearing date the 6<sup>th</sup> day of the 2<sup>d</sup> month 1702. He the said David Powel hath made returne into the General Surveyor's office of the resurvey of a tract of land resurvey the same to Joseph Fisher which being examined and revised in the said office is as followeth (viz) Situate in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a white oak being a corner tree between this and the land of John Palmer and Company thence north east by a line of marked trees and the said Palmer & Company's land 500 perches to a post thence by a line of marked trees first in the line of Samuel Carpenter's land and then by the land reputed to belong to Blumston or John Otter north west one thousand six hundred and twenty perches to a stake set near a white oak marked in the line of a parcel of land which Tho: Fairman sold to Thomas Lewis thence by the same land and a line of marked trees south west 500 perches to a post in the line of a tract of land sold by Robert Turner to Thomas Evans William Jones and Compy thence south east in the line of the lands Robert Wilson Richard Hilliard Samuel Finney Thomas Sidden and others 1620 perches to the place of beginning containing five thousand sixty and two acres. Return'd into ye Secries office the 20. of the 2<sup>d</sup> month 1702.
