By the Commissioners of Property

Whereas the Prop^{rs} by deeds of lease and release dated the first & second
days of March A.D. 1681. Granted unto Will^m Smith of Bromham house in the
 County of Wills Yeoman Twelve hundred & fifty acres of land in this Province, & ye
 sd Will^m by other like deeds in ye year 1683 Granted unto Richd Hillyard five
 hundred acres as part of the sd Purchase in right whereof there has been laid
 out to him 300 acres and his Relict — now wife of Thomas Peat sold the remain-
 ing 200 acres to Thomas Fairman of ye County of Philad^{ia} who requesting our
 warrt to take up the same. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or
 cause to be survey'd to the sd Thomas Fairman according to the method of town-
 ship appointed the said quantity of two hundred acres of vacant land in this
 Province that has not been already survey'd nor seated by the Indians and
 make returns thereof into the Secretaries office. Given under our hands and
 the seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 20th day of Octob^r 1712.
