


Pennsylvania ss.



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the request of Joann fforrest Relict and sole execut^re of William fforest late of the
ground
City of Philadelphia deed, That we would grant her a resurvey on two lots of
situuate contiguous on the Broad street at a corner of Mulberry street near the
center of the said city one whereof is in right of two hundred & fifty acres the
purchase of Thomas Wolfe the other in right of the like quantity purchased of the
Prop^rt by John Luff, both which said lots being now vested in the said Joann
fforrest. These are to authorize and require thee to resurvey or cause to be
resurvey'd unto the said Joann fforrest in the place aforesaid the above
mentioned lots of Ground according to the bounds & dimensions by which they
were at first laid out and make exact returns thereof into the Secretary's office
in order for a further Confirmation. Given under our hands & the lesser seal
of the Province at Philadelphia ye 10th day of Octob^r Anno Domⁱ 1720.
