Whereas Jeremiah Collet and John Gibbons sen<sup>r</sup>t both of ye County of Chester have for some time past severally laid claim to ye p<sup>r</sup>ference of purchasing a certain p<sup>c</sup>ell of land in ye Mannor of Rocklands joyning on ye lands of Robt Brown Wm Galley and John Mercy in Bethel township and ys lands of ye sd Jno<sup>r</sup> Gibbons and whereas the sd Jer Collet in pursuance of an award of certain arbitrators by them indifferently chosen doth resign and quitt claim all p<sup>r</sup>erence to ye sd land or any privilege therein whereupon ye sd Jno<sup>r</sup> hath requested of a grant of two hundred acres of ye sd land agreeing to pay for ye same sixty pounds at or before ye Tenth day of ye second month next and five years rent for ye time past at one Shill Sterling p<sup>c</sup> st and to be held under ye same rent forever hereafter These are to authorize and require thee forthwith to survey and lay out to ye sd John Gibbons ye sd quantity of 200 acres of land situate as aforesaid or as near ye same as may be and make returns into ye Gen<sup>t</sup> Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain & a copy thereof to be Deliv<sup>d</sup> to thee certified by ye Secretary Given under our hands and ye seal of ye Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> 23 12 m<sup>e</sup> 1702 Edw<sup>d</sup> Shippen
