

Whereas there is three hundred acres of land laid out in ye County of Philadelphia unto Richard Hilliard (Joyning to my land) which was executed Contrary to Instruction and ord's from ye Surveyor Generalls and to my Prejudece therefore do hereby enter this as a Caveat in ye Surveyor Generalls office against any further procedance of any Confirmation whatsoever to be made unto him ye said Hilliard untill we have had a full and fair hearing before ye Comrs, Concerning the same, Philadelphia ye 3rd of May 1686.
