



By virtue of a warrant from the Commiss^{rs} of Property dated the 4th day of the first month 1717/8. for surveying to James Robins five hundred acres of land (the Liberty deducted) There was surveyd in part thereof unto Joseph Shippen on the 25th day of August 1731 a tract of land in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a post at a Corner of Jacob Merkley's land Thence by the same southeast two hundred perches to a post in the line of Bebber's township thence by the said line southwest one hundred fifty four perches to a post at a corner of the said township Then by land of Rachel Dubois and John Pawlin northwest two hundred perches to a post Then by the said Pawlins land northeast one hundred fifty four perches to the place of beginning Containring One hundred eighty two acres with allowance of six per cent.
