

His third lot of past land beginning at a black oak by Crum Creek from thence by John
Sinn Cocks land south forty three degrees westerly thirty one perches to a hickory
tree from thence by the widow - Neals's land south fourty seven degrees easterly
one hundred and eight perches ~~to~~ to a white oake from thence north fourty three
degrees eastly in the line of Ed^d Pritchets land thirty seven perches to a white oak
by Crum Creek then up the several courses of the said Creek ninety one perches
to the place of beginning containing twenty four acres and a quarter.

These five parcels added together make ninety three acres ~~and~~ resurveyed by
Isaac Taylor the 13th 14th & 15th days of 8th 1701.
