At the request of Sarah Fallowfield, That we would grant her to take up two hundred and fifty acres of land Purchased of the Proprietor by Robt Robinson of Newby stones in the County of Westmoreland Yeoman by Deeds of Lease & release dated ye 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> dayes of May A.D. 1683 and by his son and Heir John Robinson assigned to the said Sarah. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd to the sd Sarah Fallowfield according to the Method of townships appointed the said quantity of two hundred and fifty acres of land in this Province that has not been already survey'd nor taken up nor is seated by the Indians. And make returns thereof into the Secretaries office. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1713.
