At ye request of Edward Green, yt I would grant him to take up two hundred acres of land at Susquehannah, or, if not layd out any there before ye spring next, in any of ye Countys already fift here. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd number of acres according to ye promises he seating & improving ye same within one year from ye date of survey, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 2^d of ye 6th 1684.
