

 as may be. These are to will & require thre forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to  
 be survey'd unto her ye sd number of acres in ye aforementioned County  
 & place, where not already taken up, according to ye method of towns  
 hips appointed by me, he seating & improving ye same within one year  
 after ye date of survey, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's  
 office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 19<sup>th</sup> of ye 5<sup>th</sup> mo. 1684.
