At ye request of Thomas Garrett, yt I would grant him to take up a neck of land supposed to be about forty acres, bounding upon a neck of Neamans Creek, Francis Smith, Thomas Usher & William Cloud seated together on ye said Creek in ye County of Chester. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him ye said neck of lands, provided it be not already taken up, according to ye method of townships appointed by me & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at New Castle ye 14th of ye 3^d mo 1684.
