These ~~heretofore~~ are to authorize and require thee to resurvey or cause to be resurveyed unto the said Joshua Hastings the ^d quantity of land with as ^{little} disadvantage to the remaining land as maybe done and make a return of the said one hundred & eighty acres and no more, into the Secretary's office in order for a further confirmation. Given under our hands & seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 23 day of the 2^d month Anno Dni 1716.
