These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be Surveyed to ye Proprietarys use the aforesaid thirty seven acres with such fronting upon ye Mill Creek as with Convenientcy may be, and make Returns hereoff to ye Secret<sup>r</sup>s Office Dated at Philadelphia ye 9<sup>th</sup> of ye
