These are therefore in ye Proprietaries name to will and require thee Worth with to examin thy office for the said warrant, but if not found andt ye said one hundred and fifty acres thou finds formerly Laird out Then thou art hereby required to Certifie it to ye Secretaryes office the time ye same was laid out with ye Bounds and Courses thereof dated at Philadelphia ye 5th of ye 2^d mo 1689.
