vacand Land to a post by a chesnot then East two hundred and sixty
five pearches by vacand Land to a black oak then South one hundred
and sixty pearches by vacand Land to a post in moris old line about
one hundred and twenty pearches from the east corner Then along by
moris old tract west two hundred and sixty five pearches to the place
of begining Containing two hundred and sixty five acres of land.
