At ye Request of Margary Plumley yt I would grant her to take
up Two hundred & fifty Acres head right near Nashomeni Creek where
she now liveth. These are to (oblig) and require thee forthwth to survey, or
cause to be survey'd unto her ye s^d number of Acres in ye aforementioned
place, where not already taken up, according to ye method of Townships
appointed by me, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office.
Given at Philadelphia ye 26th of ye 1st mo 1683
