& delivered to thee sometime since might be layd out as soon as possible,
& as convenient as may be: And upon request of Jn^o Flackney & Tho. Marel &
Sarah Philips y^t at y^t & in ye same place their head land might be sett
out also; These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to
be surveyd for James Packson one hundred Acres, William Packson one
hundred, Peter Tremain one hundred, John Flackney one hundred Acres,
& Thomas Marel & Sarah Philips one hundred Acres, having due regard to ye
Purchasers, & ye Method of Townships agreed on; & this shall be thy Warrant.
Given at Philadelphia ye 24th of ye 11th M^o 1682
