

Resurveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of the 1<sup>st</sup> month 170 $\frac{1}{2}$  by virtue of a Warrt. from the Com<sup>rs</sup>. of Property dated the 21<sup>st</sup>. of the 11<sup>th</sup>. month 1701 unto Joseph Growdon a Tract laid out for John Bowen in Bensalem Township. Containing 273<sup>A</sup>. 3<sup>R</sup>. 2<sup>P</sup>. Beginning at a Ditch by the River Delaware. Thence by Jonas Sheen's line N. 13 degrs. W. 338 perches to a white oak. Then E. 18 degrs. N by Fairman's line 160 perches to a white oak by a Rock at Neshameneh Creek. Then down the several Courses of the said Creek to the mouth thereof. Then down the several Courses of the River Delaware to the place of beginning.
