



Whereas There was formerly a warnt granted by  
ye Late Commiss<sup>n</sup>s. unto John Gray bearing date ye  
22<sup>d</sup> of ye 12<sup>th</sup>. mo. 1685/6 to Resurvey a tract of Land on ye west  
side of Neshamaniess Creek ye which belonged to Dunk Will-  
iams and ffrancis Walker Joyntly and held ffor ye quantity of  
ffour hundred & ffifty acres the over-plus of which was grant-  
ed by ye said warnt. unto John Gray. Since which it hath pleas-  
-ed ye Proprietary to sell ye said overplus unto ye said John  
Gray and thereupon Lent his positive order. Directed unto us  
bearing date ye 9<sup>th</sup> of ye 10<sup>th</sup>. Mo. 1687. Willing and Requiring us  
to putt ye said John Gray into quiett possession of ye same.  
These are Therefore in ye Proprietary's name to will and Require  
Thee fforthwith to make an Executed Returne of ye aforesaid  
warnt. bearing Date ye 22 of ye 12<sup>th</sup>. mo. 1685/6 unto ye Secretary's  
office notwithstanding a Letter bearing date ye 23<sup>d</sup> of ye 12<sup>th</sup>.  
mo. 1685/6 Directed unto Thomas ffairman fforbiding him to  
Execute ye same. Given at Philadelphia ye Sixth day of ye  
Second - 1688.
