

William Penn Absolute Proprietary & Govrn'r in  
Chief of the Province of Pensilvania and Counties  
Annexed.

At the Request of the Heirs of Joseph Milnor That I would  
grant them a Resurvey on a certain Tract of Land in Make-  
field Township Adjoyning on their other Tracts Laid out  
for two hundred and fifty Acres. These are to require thee  
forthwith to Resurvey or cause to be resurvey'd the sd. Tract  
of 250 Acres according to the first Boundy. and Lines of  
Survey and make Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office  
Given under my hand and Seal at Philadlia. the 31<sup>st</sup>. day  
of the 3<sup>d</sup> Month, 1701.
