 to <sup>be</sup> resurvey'd unto the Said Samuel Gilbert, <sup>in</sup> the Place aforesaid  
 the Said Quantity of Two hundred and Forty six Acres  
 of Land in Order to compleat the Said Purchase [Should soe  
 much be found Due to him] and make <sup>a</sup> returnne thereof  
 into the Secretary's Office Given under our hands and  
 Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the twenty Sixth day  
 of the Third Month Anno Domini 1714.
