

In pursuance of a General Warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 5<sup>th</sup>. of the 11<sup>th</sup>. month 1702 for Resurveying of Lands in the County of Bucks This may Certifie that in August Anno 1703 there was Resurveyd for John Hart a Tract of Land in the Township of Warmister in the County of Bucks.

Beginning at a Small Hickery tree at a Corner of John Rush's <sup>reputed</sup> Land Thence running north forty Six degrees West by the Lands of William Bingly and Abel Noble two hundred sixty five pches to a post Then North East by George Randal's Land three hundred twenty eight perches to another post. Thence South West by the Land of Joseph, <sup>Lawrence</sup> ~~two~~ two hundred sixty four pches to a black oak Sapling. Then by the Land of the said John Rush South West three hundred twenty four pches to the first mentioned Hickery Sapling Containing five hundrd. and thirty seven Acres. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 18<sup>th</sup>. Day of November Anno 1717.
