William Penn, Proprietary & Governr. of ye Province of Pennsilvania, & ye Territories thereunto belonging.

At ye Request of Abraham Man, yt I would grant him to take up Two hundred Acres in ye County of Bucks joyning to ye Line of Richard Noble's Land, lyng back on ye North side of Nashamens Creek. & fronting ye River Delaware.

These are to will & require thee forthwth. to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him ye sd. Number of Acres in ye aforementioned County & Place, allowing him Sixty Perches front on ye River Delaware, North of ye sd. Richard Noble, & to runn backward into ye Woods to ye Proportion of TWO hundred Acres & make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 16th ^{JAN} _{mo} 1683.
