Lundy, John Large, Joseph Gilbert and other Land of ^{ye said} Mathew Hughs containing about Sixty eight acres for which He agrees to pay to the use of the Proprietary Trustees Ten pounds Mory of Pensilvania and the yearly quitrent of eight pence Sterling for the same.

These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey & lay out or cause to be Survey'd and laid out unto the Said Mathew Hughs in the place aforesaid according as is above described, the said parcel of vacant Land adjoining the same on the aforesaid Tracts and make exact Returns thereof into ye Secretary's Office in order for a further Confirmation Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 15th day of Xbr Anno Domini 1719.
