fore mentioned County and his Proportion of Land wthin
ye Liberties of ye City of Philadelphia, in a place not already
taken up according to ye Method of Township appointed by
ye Governn^r. and make he Setting and Improvieng upon ye
same wthin six moneths after ye Date of Survey and make
returne thereof into ye Governn^rs Secretaryes office.
