Joseph Kirl his full Right of twenty five foot in breadth, to w^m. Bowlin his claim of One hundred and fifty ~~one~~ One feet, he making his Title good to the same. and to the Claimers of the Adjacent Lots their respective Rights. Confining the sd. Philip England to the just quantity of — Acres granted him as aforesd.
