These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will  
and require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd  
unto him ye said number of acres in ye aforesaid County  
where not already taken up according to ye method of town-  
ships appoynted by ye Govern<sup>t</sup> he seating and improving  
the same within six months after ye date of survey and make  
returne hereof to ye Secretarys office dated at Philadel-  
phia ye 12<sup>th</sup> 6mo. 1685.
