


By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietary and Governor bearing date the 21st of 8th 1701 for laying out unto Andreas Rudman ten thousand acres of land for the use of himself and several of the Swedes.

There is survey'd and layd out to Morton Morton in part of the said ten thousand acres one thousand two hundred acres of land situuate on the east side of Schuylkil in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a post by the said river Schuylkil at the corner of the land of Andrew Peterson Longacre then running by the same north twenty degrees east one thousand one hundred and eighty eight perches to a post then by vacant land east south east eight hundred ninety one perches to a post at the corner of Otto Ernest Cocks land then by the same south twenty deg. west one thousand one hundred ~~one~~ and fifty five perches to a post by ~~the~~ Schuylkil then up the same bounding thereon to the place of the beginning survey'd by David Powell the 24th of the 5th month 1704

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this second day of December 1909
