At ye request of Katharine Martin widdow yt I would grant her to take up a lott in ye city of Philadelphia proportionable to her purchase offive hundred acres.

These are to will and require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto her a lott on Delaware side in ye streets sett out for purchasers of ye like quantity and make returnis thereof into my Secretary's office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 13th A^th M^o. 1683.
