At ye request of Charles Marshall purchaser of one thousand acres yt I would grant him to take up his lotts of ye City & land wthin ye liberties proportionable. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd lotts & land wthin ye bounds & liberties aforesd. Also fifty one foot of one of ye corner lotts of ye high street on Shulkill side ye back of ye front street reserved by my special order for ye consideration of five thousand acres lately purchased and make returnis thereof into my Secretary's office
