

By vertue of a warrt from ye Com^{ee} dated ye 24th of ye 11th mo. 1690 directed to the Survey^r General I do by authority ffrom him certifie into the Secret^r Y^s Office that there was surveyed and laid out ye same day unto Peter Nelson old rente, ffour certain p^eeces or pr^cills of land in ye township of Shakamaxunk in ye county of Philadelphia. The first p^eece or pr^cill begineth at a corn^t black oak of Jn^e Tonks land thence N.N.W. by the same one hundred twenty eight perches to a corn^t post of Robert Turners land thence 5.60^d wly by ye said Turners land one hundred and eighty perches to a corn^t post standing by ye swamp^e side ffrom thence downe ye severall courses of ye same to a corn^t white oak of Jn^e Tonks ffrom thence 5.16^d E^{ly} one hundred and ten^m perches to a corn^t post standing near ye river Delaware ffrom thence ffollowing up ye severall courses thereof and ye swamp^e to the first mentioned place of begining being one hundred and fifty acres. The second p^eece or pr^cill begineth at a corn^t white oak of Wm^m Prestons thence S.S.E. by a line of trees eighty perches to a corn^t post standing by a swamp^e or cripole ffrom thence following downe ye severall courses thereof to a corn^t post of Robert Turners land thence ~~5.5.~~ N.N.W. by ye same one hundred twenty five perches, ffrom thence E.N.E. by a line of trees one hundred forty three perches to ye first mentioned place of begining being hanty acres of land. The third p^eece or pr^cill begineth at a corn^t white oak standing by ye meadow side ffrom thence N.N.W. by a line of trees one hundred eighty four perches to a corn^t white oak standing by a swamp^e side ffrom thence ffollowing downe ye severall courses thereof to a corn^t post of Gunnor Rambos land thence S.S.E. by ye same 177 perches to a corn^t post standing by ye afore mentionned meadow ffrom thence ffollowing up ye severall courses thereof to ye place of begining being one hundred and ninety acres of land the fourth p^eece or pr^cill ~~begineth~~ is ye one equall halfe of a p^eece of meadow swamp^e and cripole containing in ye whole sixty seven acres which said tract is bounded to ye N.E. with Gunnor Ramboes meadow and cripole S.E. with ye river Delaware S.W. with John Tonks meadows and cripole and to ye N.W. with Gunnor Ramboes and Peter Nelsons fast land which said tract of sixty seven acres is laid out unto ye said Peter Nelson and Mickell Nelson in which boath are equally concerned containing in all ye ffour (afore mentionned) pr^cills 468 acres and a halfe which is accordingly entred and recorded in the Survey^r General's office at Philadelphia ye 6th of ye 8th mo. 1691
