


Pennsylvania

At the request of William Thomas of Radnor that we would grant him a resurvey on one hundred fifty ~~and~~ three acres and a quarter of land laid out in Radnor aforesaid by virtue of a general warrant from the prop'ty dated the 13<sup>th</sup> of the first month 1684 in right of Richard Humphry purchaser under Richd Davies original purchaser of 5000 acres these are to require thee to resurvey to the said William Thomas the said quantity of one hundred fifty three acres and a quarter. Situate and laid out as aforesaid and make return thereof into the General Surveyor's office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be deliv'd to thee certified by the Secretary who is to take a duplicate of thy return into his office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 16<sup>th</sup> of ye 12<sup>th</sup> mo<sup>'th</sup> 1701.
