certify that I have surveyed to Edward Thomas suppucher under

acres beginning at a corner marked Heckry being ye northwesterly
bounds of ye second township situat joining to Readmer township
within ye bounds of ye Welsh tract from thence north eighty five
degrees East 160 parcias to a corner marked post thence south
south east by ye land of Thomas Jones 306 to a post being a cor-
ner of land laid out for Davied Davies from ^{thence} by a line of a marked
trees dividing from ye said Daves land west south west 150 par-
cias to a Heckry in a line of ye said second township from the edge
by ye said line North North west 364 parcias to ye place of begin-
ning surveyed according to ye bounes above described for
312 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres ye 12^d of 12 m^o 1685.
