 month last past & is accordingly returned into the Surveyor
 General's office by virtue of a war^t from the Comisin's bering dat.

Capt Markam Thomas Ellis requests of thee to grant a patent
 for thiobl. tract of land above sd because he is concarned for
 the man & he wiobl. if possible have it to send in this ship &
 Robart Longstar being recip oblique of certifieing at present would
 in treat thee to accept of this & he oblique certifiey it when he is
 able, this from thy obledged frined & servant.
