William Penn Proprietary & Govern<sup>t</sup> of ye Province of Pennsilvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging.

At ye request of Robert Taylor purchaser of one thousand acres yt I would grant him to take up ye remainder (viz<sup>t</sup>) six hundred acres in ye County of Chester. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd number of acres in ye afore mention'd County where not already taken up according to ye method of townships appointed by me and make returns thereof into my Secretarys office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 26<sup>th</sup> October 1683.
