ye remainde^r of his purchase being five hundred & thirty acres
in ye County of Chester. These are in ye Proprietary's name
to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be surveyed
unto him ye sd number of acres in ye aforementioned County
where not already taken up after ^{all} former marr^{ts} executed
he seating & improving ye same wth six months from ye
date of survey & make returns thereon into the Secretary's
office. Given at Philadelphia ye 27th of 11th mo. 1681


