Whereas Thomas Ellis in his life time upon several grants of land made to him by ye Prop'ty & Comm'ee among other tracts in this Province did take up in ye Great Valley in ye Welsh tract five hundred acres of land purchased of ye Proprietary of wh^t upon some agreement made between himself & Bartholomew Rowles of Haverford West in ye County of Pembroke he allotted to ye sd Bartholomew — one moiety or two hundred and fifty acres and whereas at ye request of ye sd Barthol. — by his friend we issued our warrant of resurvey bearing date ye sixteenth day of ye 12 month 170² directed to David Powel requiring ye sd David — to resurvey to ye sd Bartholomew — ye sd quantity of two hundred and fifty acres situate in ye sd Valley in right of ye sd Thomas Ellis's purchase wh^t sd two hundred & fifty acres ~~were intended to be one moiety of ye sd tract of five hundred acres aforesaid of wh^t ye other moiety doth now of right belong to Robert Wharton and his wife Rachel daughter of ye sd Thomas Ellis now these are at ye request of ye sd Robert — to authorize you both or either of you to resurvey exactly ye sd ^{whole} tract of five hundred acres according to ye outlines thereof and by such a reasonable partition line as shall equally divide ye same both in quantity quality & value in the improvement excepted all respects ^{Abo} wh^t you are to advise w^t Samuel Carpenter formerly Attorney to ye sd Bartholomew — and some intelligent and impartial person inhabitants of ye Welsh tract to lay out two hundred and fifty acres or one full moiety thereof to ye sd Bart Rowles, pursuant to our aforerecited warrant including therein ye building of Owen Thomas and ye other moiety to ye sd Rob^t Wharton and make distinct returns into ye Gen^l Surveyors office at Philad^{ia} by a copy hereof certified by ye Secretary. Given at Philad^{ia} ye 23-12th 1702.~~
