Surveyed for John Vanclein 50 acres of land lying one the north side of the great Crum Creek and on the east side of the little Crum Creek begining at the mouth of the little Crum Creek and runing up the sd little Crum Creek on severall courses to a marked white oak standing by the sd creek from thence runing e. 80 perch by the land of John Henreckson to a marked white oak from thence runing N. 24 perch to a marked spanisobl oak standing at the head of ^{by} a run then runing down the sd run on severall courses to the great Crum Creek and up the great Crum Creek on severall courses to the first mencherred begining at the mouth of little Crum Creek.
