Surveyed for Georg Woodyard 200 acres of land lieing on the east
side of ridly creek begining at a marked popler being the markt
tree of John haulsons land and running along the sd haulsons line
of marked trees N.E.b.N. 365 percht to a markt whit oak from
thence N.N.W. 104 percht to a markt red oak from thence S.W.b.S.
385 percht to a markt red oak standing by ridly creek and
down the creek on severall corses to the first menchedered pop-
ler.
