

Surveyd the 4th of the 4th month 1717 by virtue of the Comm^{r's} warrant
dated the 16th of the 3^d month 1717 unto Nicholas White a certain
tract of land in Boskem in the County of Chester for wh^c he agreed
to pay to the Proprietors use after the rate of fifteen pounds £
hundred acres beginning at a black oak at a corn^t of William
Hudsons land thence north twenty five degrees west by the land
of Edward Jones one hundred and eighty ft to a small hick-
ery tree then north obly five degrees easterly two hundred ~~sixty three~~
^{thirty six} ft to a ob^l oak then south twenty five degrees easterly one
hundred ob^l eighty ft to a small hickery then south sixty five
degob^l westerly by the said Wm Hudsons land two hundred obly
six ft to the place of place of beginning contain ob^l two hun-
dred and fifty acres and an allowance of six ft ob^l. Returned
into the ob^lary's office May 16th 1718. Jacob Taylor
