

By vertue of an order directed to me from the proprietor of this province
bearing date the 28 of the 4 month 1683 to resurvey the oould enhabitanee
land in the county of Chester, ~~hereabout~~ July the 11, 1683

Then resurveied for Robert Wade 560 acres of land lieing on the west side
of Chester creek begining at the mouth of the sd creek and runing
along the river side on severall courses to a run called Lamokin run being
the east bounds of albert land and runing up the sd run on severall courses to
a marked white oak and from thence runing N.W.b.N. 128 peritch to a marked beech
tree standing by Chester creek and from thence runing down the creek on severall
courses to mouth thereof being the first menchened bounds P Charles Ashcom

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in
the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,
this twenty sixth day of June 1909
