General Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this warrant  
is to remain & a copy thereof to be transmitted to thee cer-  
tified by the Secretary who is also to take a duplicate of  
thy return into his office. Given under our hands and the  
seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 25<sup>th</sup> of the first month  
1702.
