name to will and require thee fforthwith to survey or cause
to be survey'd unto him ye said number of acres in ye a-
fore said county where not already taken up according to
ye method of townships apoynted by ye Gover^r he seat-
ing and improving the same within six months after ye
date of survey and make returne hereoff to ye Secretarys
office dated at Philadelphia ye 13th of ye 7^{mo}. 1686.
