

These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out to the sd Peter Chamberlain in the City of Philadelphia proportionable to the Purchase aforesaid as conveniently as may be where not already Survey'd or taken up, and make returns into the Genl Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrt is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 25<sup>th</sup> of the 4<sup>th</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> 1705.
