 Carpenter/Purchas<sup>t</sup> of ffive Thousand acres) his Lott  
 in y<sup>e</sup> Libertys of Philadelphia Beginning at a Corner white  
 oak Standing near unto a Small Runn being A Corner  
 of Thomas Fairmans Land thence E.N.E. by a line of trees  
 one hundred and ffive perches thence S.S.E. by a line  
 of trees one hundred Thirty Eight p'ches to a Corner post  
 being a Corner of Robert Turners Land thence W.S.W. by  
 Bowyers Land ffifty ffour perches to a Corin<sup>t</sup> tree thereof  
 Standing by y<sup>e</sup> afore mentioned Runn thence ffollowing along  
 y<sup>e</sup> Severall Courses thereof to y<sup>e</sup> place of begining containing  
 Eighty acres of Land which is accordingly Entred and Record-  
 ed in y<sup>e</sup> Survey<sup>t</sup> Generalls office at Philadelphia y<sup>e</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 3<sup>d</sup>  
 m<sup>o</sup> 1691
