William's Lott in Chesnut Street in y^e City of Philad^{ia}
bounded by the Sd Lott and Walnut Street, ^{Lotts} of equal
Breadth with his Sd Lott and Depth about forty or fifty
foot at the Yearly rent of five Shillings

And make Return thereof into the Secretary Office Given
under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadel-
phia the twenty fourth day of November 1701.
